

Madison half-marathon and 5k race courses and traffic impacts - 8/18/18

Roads will be closed and reopened on a rolling basis as runners move through the courses. The only complete road closure is N. Park Street between University Avenue and Langdon Street. The first race begins at 7 a.m. and all roads should be reopened by noon. Event details at madisonminimarathon.com.

Vehicle traffic can travel along the races' UW routes as follows:

Routes

- Half-marathon
- 5k

NB - northbound
SB - southbound
EB - eastbound
WB - westbound

N. Lake Street (University to W. Dayton) - NB only

W. Dayton Street (N. Lake to Randall) - EB only

N. Randall Street (W. Dayton to Drake*) - SB only
*Race loops down around the zoo and the arboretum

Monroe Street (N. Randall to Regent) - NB only

N Breese Terrace (Regent to University) - SB only

University Avenue (N. Breese Terrace to Walnut) - EB only

Walnut Street - SB only
*Access to Lots 60 and 76 and University Bay Drive available via the inner lane around Lot 60. Traffic access will be limited when runners are present.

University Bay Drive (Lake Mendota Dr to Walnut) - SB only

Observatory Drive (Walnut to Elm + Elm to Babcock) - EB only

Elm Drive (Lakeshore Path to Observatory) - SB only

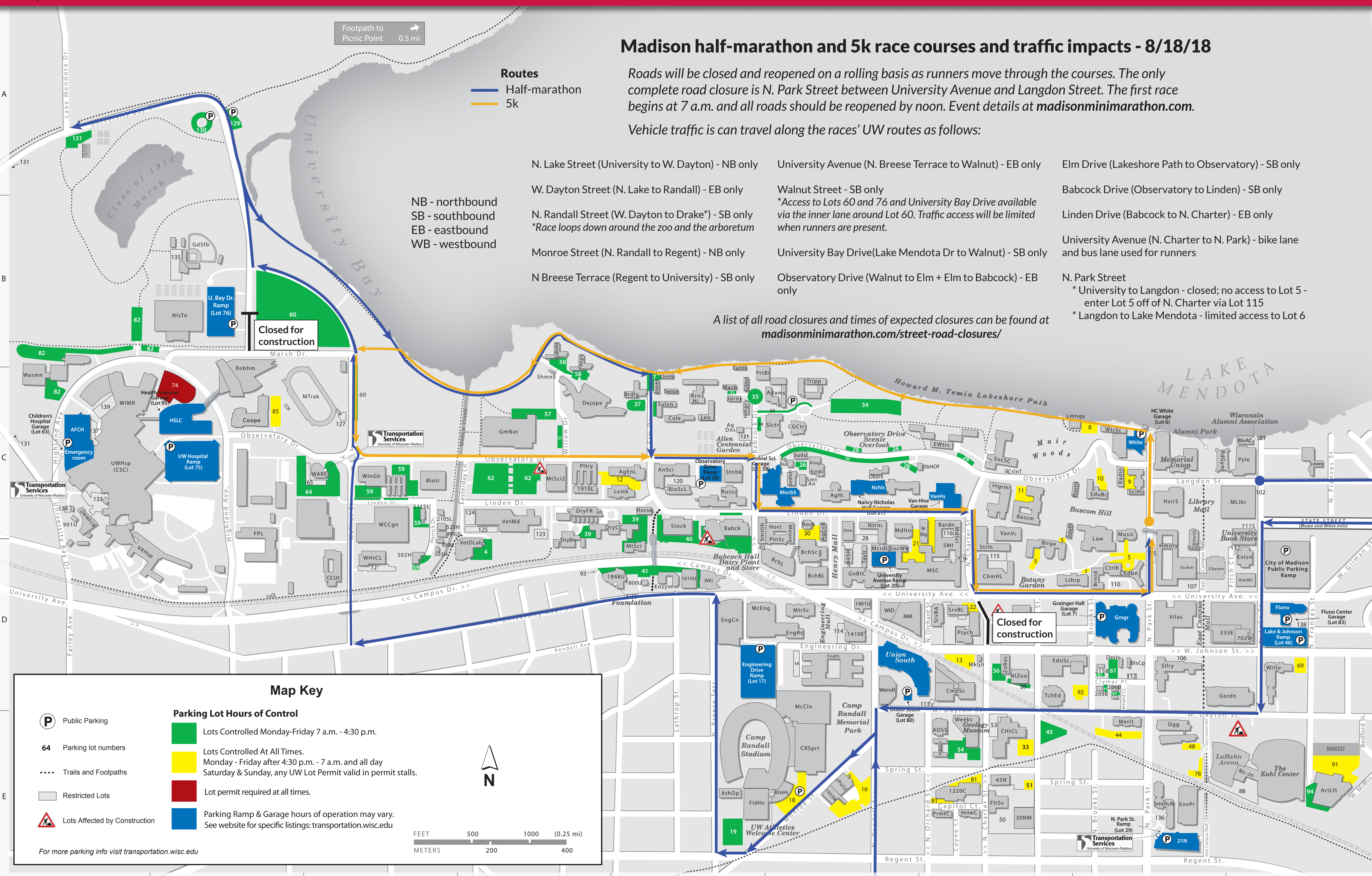
Babcock Drive (Observatory to Linden) - SB only

Linden Drive (Babcock to N. Charter) - EB only

University Avenue (N. Charter to N. Park) - bike lane and bus lane used for runners

N. Park Street
* University to Langdon - closed; no access to Lot 5 - enter Lot 5 off of N. Charter via Lot 115
* Langdon to Lake Mendota - limited access to Lot 6
