2. Director's Report: P. Kass

- **Linden Garage Project Presentation**
 - Meeting with Joint Area Campus Committee for approval
- **Lot 129/130 Presentation**
 - Continues to be on track to start construction summer 2019.
- **New Legislation on e-Scooters**
 - Companies like Bird & Lime are receiving blowback for dumping e-scooters in WI cities.
 - It is currently illegal to operate e-scooters on public roads in the State of Wisconsin.
 - Looking for local government to regulate
- **2018 Biennial Survey – presented by P. Armstrong**
 - Commuting and transportation trends
 - Conducted since 1970
 - Online Questionnaire since 2010
 - Three Surveys:
 - Currently enrolled UW students
 - UW- Madison faculty and staff
 - WU Hospital employees working at the main campus
 - Qualtrics Survey of 26 questions and comment box at the end
 - Sample size – target of 500 responses (email invitation with reminder emails)
 - 2000 UW Faculty & Staff - 14.2% response rate
 - 2000 UW Hospital employees - 30.9% response rate
 - 3500 UW Students - 31.4% response rate
 - Conducted cross tabs on survey data, including travel mode and weather
 - Looked at trends going back to 2012

- Other Useful Data includes:
 - Campus arrival and departure times
 - Frequency driving to campus
 - Frequency riding Metro bus service
 - Frequency riding campus bus routes
 - Frequency riding a bicycle to campus
 - Cross Tab – Mode by income
 - Cross Tab – Mode by Residence (students)
 - Cross Tab – Mode by Status (students)
 - The survey provides:
 - Snapshot of transportation patterns
 - Help better serve our customers
 - Tracking trends over time leads to improvements
- **Commuter Solutions Update** –Dar Ward
 - We have received the data from Madison Metro on passengers boarding and exiting buses.
 - Bus rapid transit – a need for larger, faster buses is in the works. Will need a federal grant

- Feedback from the University Committee Meeting
 - Flex Parking:
 - Availability of Flex parking information in the Parking Application Systems (PAS)
 - Number of permits available for issue
 - Maximum number of permits available for Flex lots
 - T. Teal-Tate to provide a list; Number of Flex permits available/issued in each Flex lot.
 - Parking permit for low wage night workers:
 - Current options include: Garage Specific permit - \$45 and Surface Lots permit - \$130
 - Only one price increase - \$5 in 7 years.
 - Need for inter-city bus parking:
 - Van Gilder Bus stop at Memorial Union is an issue
 - In the plan to park near Lake Street City Ramp
 - Will continue to monitor and work on bus parking issues
