- Flex Parking Letters to Customers:
 - Transportation Services issued letters to Flex customers that have not paid for their Flex parking resulting in unpaid balances.
 - This is not a new policy for Transportation Services.
 - Pay when you park program has been around for a long time.
 - Flex is a self-reporting program.
 - o Transportation Services has made a concentrated effort to manage usage & payment regarding the Flex program.
 - o Transportation Services can only monitored the gated lots for entry and exit.
 - Surface lots are monitor by checking Flex parker's status to see if it is in paid mode.
 - o Approximately 500 letters went out to customers with unpaid accounts.
