*Reduced cost permit options*

At the request of campus administration, UW Transportation Services [created a few reduced and low-cost product options](#) during the 2020-21 parking year for certain lower wage-earning employee groups:

- UW graduate and professional students
- UW and UW Hospital employees with a UW salary less than \$35,000 per year in base wages

These offerings were originally intended only for the 2020-21 parking year. A **one-time extension** has been granted for the 2021-22 parking year. This program will not be extended in the future.

Reduced cost permit options include:

- A semester permit: Fall 2021 or Spring 2022\* - \$253 per semester

- Reduced cost base lot permit\* - \$606
- Reduced cost monthly permit - \$55

\*The prices for these products increased one percent (1%) to match the increased rates of equivalent permit types.
