• Fall 22021 Program Updates

- We are still trying to determine how our operations will look in the fall of 2021.
- Continue to be flexible in our planning. Permit application process will be delayed until next month. We will be flexible with permit exchanges as employee figure out their work situations.
- Planning on an increase in flex parking
- o TS will continue to offer a lower rate permit for those making \$35,000 or less annually.
- Capital projects have been shifted back 2 years as far as maintenance and construction of new garages/ramps.
- o Continue to work with Madison Metro on bus ridership and safety of buses.

- Bicycle Maintenance Classes
 - Virtual class will go through June 2021

- Campus Bus
 - After commencement the buses will go to recess schedule and will discontinue the trailer buses on campus and with the park and rides.
