**Reduced cost parking permit program**

At the request of campus administration, UW Transportation Services [created a few reduced and low-cost product options](#) during the 2020-21 parking year for certain lower wage-earning employee groups.

These offerings were originally intended only for the 2020-21 parking year and were continued through the 2021-22 parking year. The program will be extended through the 2022-23 parking year for the following groups:

- *July 2022 update:* Most UW graduate and professional students with a biweekly pay rate less than \$1468.
- *July 2022 update:* UW and UW Hospital employees with a gross hourly pay rate less than \$18.35 per hour.

Reduced cost permit options for 2022-23 include:

- Semester permit: Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 - \$256 per semester
- Reduced cost base lot permit - \$612

### Parking rates

The Flex parking program daily rate maximum will increase to \$12 per day (80% of the daily visitor parking rate maximum of \$15). Flex parking hourly rates will also increase to 80% of hourly visitor parking rates. See chart below for rate information. ### Product rates

The Flex Gated parking program will charge an up-front cost of \$12 for permits assigned to gated lots only. These funds paid up-front will be applied as \$15 of value to the customer’s Flex parking account and will be available for the customer to use to pay for parking.

### Product discontinuations

The multi-day parking pass will no longer be offered in the following lots: 6 Upper, 7, 17, 20, 29, 36, 46, 67, 80, or 83.

Monthly reduced cost permits will no longer be offered.

Semester permits will no longer be offered in Lots 44 or 45.

### Policy changes

*The Flex parking policy has been updated to define policies for the use of Flex permits in gated lots:*

**Change:** The Flex parking policy will stipulate the following:

- Flex Gated permit holders must pay for parking in advance by adding funds to their eBusiness account.
- Flex Gated permit holders must have a positive parking account balance to enter their assigned parking lot with the Flex permit.
- Flex Gated permit holders may exit their assigned parking lot with a zero or negative parking account balance.
- Flex Gated permit holders must pay off any negative account balance before adding more value to a parking account or purchasing any other Transportation Services products.
- Flex Gated permit holders must have an account balance of at least \$12.50 in value (\$10 cash) to be eligible to return their permit for a refund on or before June 30.
- Flex Gated permit holders will not be allowed to return the permit for a refund after June 30.
- If Flex Gated permit holders want to park after 4:30 pm on weekdays or Saturday/Sunday in surface lots where UW permits are valid, they must create an account with ParkMobile and use ParkMobile to pay for parking.
- Flex Surface permit holders will continue to use ParkMobile to pay for parking at the start of each parking session.

#### *Reduced cost permit policy*

**Change:** *The reduced cost permit policy will be formalized and include the following items:*

- Annual base lot and semester permits are available at a reduced cost rate.
- The reduced cost permit rate is subject to approved rate increases.
- Reduced cost parking permits are only available to those meeting the following eligibility criteria:
  - *July 2022 update:* Most UW graduate and professional students earning less than a biweekly pay rate threshold.
  - *July 2022 update:* UW employees and UW Hospital and Clinics employees making less than a gross hourly pay rate.
- *July 2022 update:* Annual base lot permits are available in any lot on campus where full-price annual base lot permits are offered.
- Semester permits are available in the following lots: 17, 29, 36, 46, 67, 75, 76, and 83.
- All other rules and regulations governing UW parking permits apply to reduced cost parking permits.
