Reduced cost parking permit program

At the request of campus administration, UW Transportation Services <u>created reduced and low-cost product options</u> during the 2020-21 parking year for certain lower wage-earning employee groups.

These offerings were originally intended only for the 2020-21 parking year but were continued through the 2021-22 parking year and subsequently expanded in the 2022-23 parking year. The existing program will be extended through the 2023-24 parking year with a 2% increase in the salary threshold necessary to qualify for consideration in the program.
