#### 2. Transportation Services Reports & Updates

- Assistant Vice Chancellor Updates: Patrick Kass, Assistant Vice Chancellor
  - Presentation: Salary Based Permit Analysis
    - Background
      - University leaders and shared governance requested a report
      - TS tested multiple salary-based scenarios
      - Used ten peer institutions
      - Demand for daily on-campus parking has changed since COVID
      - Demand up 10% in PY24 as compared to prior years
      - Drive-alone rate still only 56% (vs. 70% nationally)
      - Over 50% decrease in Metro ridership vs. re-pandemic levels
      - Bus pass sales have decreased by more than 25%
      - 9,000 permit stalls are at capacity
      - Only 43% of UW & UW Health employees have a PY24 base lot or Flex permit.
